

About Your ATM Card

Say goodbye to "banker's hours" and start banking around YOUR schedule! HPECU's ATM Card gives you access to your checking, savings or both accounts - 24 hours a day, 7 days a week - all year!

ATM Transactions

Use your HPE ATM Card to:

- Withdraw Cash
- Transfer money from one account to another
- Check the current balances on your accounts
- Make Point-of-Sale purchases at participating grocery and retail stores!

ATM Locations

HPE Credit Union is a member of the NYCE, EXCHANGE, and CIRRUS networks. This allows you to use your HPECU ATM Card at over 250,000 locations worldwide! Just look for the logos on Automated Teller Machines and in many grocery and retail stores.



Personal Identification Number (PIN)

A PIN is a four digit number code to help protect against fraud. When your ATM card is inserted into any machine or used to make a point-of-sale purchase, you will automatically be instructed to enter your PIN code. The ATM card cannot be used without it. For safety, choose a PIN that is not likely to be familiar to others, and don't share this number with anyone. **Never write your PIN on your ATM card.**

Joint Account Owners

If an account is under joint ownership, each owner may have access to the account through the ATM. However, each individual must apply for and receive a separate HPECU ATM Card with their own Personal Identification Number.

ATM Card Fees

The card is **Free**. Please refer to the Schedule of Fees and Charges for the current fees associated with using the card.

Most ATM Transaction Fees can be avoided by using the ATM card to withdraw cash from the Share Draft Checking Account.
